





### **Danger Level 1 - Low**







#### Wind slabs require caution.

The mostly small wind slabs are in some cases still prone to triggering, in particular at elevated altitudes. Avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular on very steep shady slopes above approximately 2400 m and in gullies and bowls. They are easy to recognise.

In steep terrain there is a danger of falling on the hard snow surface.

### Snowpack

**Danger patterns** 

dp.6: cold, loose snow and wind

The old snowpack is largely stable. The mostly small wind slabs of the last few days are in individual cases still prone to triggering, especially on very steep shady slopes and at elevated altitudes. On sunny slopes the snowpack is better bonded.

Outgoing longwave radiation during the night will be reduced in some case.

# Tendency

Slight increase in avalanche danger as a consequence of new snow and wind.
